

Andrew Tarrant – Instructor



Andrew was Born in England and moved to Canada when he was seven. Graduating from ACAD in 1990 with a specialization in Ceramics he has worked under the studio name Trespasser Ceramics since that time. His work is both shown and sold internationally and he has pieces in many notable collections around the world. In 2003 his piece entitled “Chaos Theory” was selected to be part of the Faenza International Contemporary Ceramics Exhibition in Italy.

His wide range of artistic knowledge includes wood-carving, glasswork, jewellery and metal-working, leatherworking and sculptural studies, as well as design and architectural detailing.

In addition Andrew has managed and chaired various arts organizations and volunteers teaching time at some of the local schools. He also taught various ceramic and arts programs for the City of Calgary Parks and Recreation Department, the Red Deer College Series Program, and regularly travels to teach workshops. Andrew was most recently the artist in residence at the Children’s Museum at the Telus World of Science. In 2005 he was also awarded an AFA grant to attend a session at the Banff Centre for the Arts to create a body of work for a new exhibition.
